Koontz Electric Company, Inc. Awarded West Point Power Project Main Power Distribution Equipment Upgrade and Replacement

Morrilton, Arkansas – Koontz Electric Company, Inc. (KECI) has just been awarded a \$4.2 million dollar prime contract with the Mobile District of the US Army Corps of Engineers to upgrade and replace the main power distribution equipment at the West Point Dam & Powerhouse in West Point, Georgia.

West Point Dam and Powerhouse sits on West Point Lake which extends 35 miles along the Alabama – Georgia state line. It is part of the Apalachicola-Chattahoochee-Flint Waterway system, which runs 260 Miles from Columbus, Georgia to Apalachicola, Florida. The power plant came online in 1975 and the current plant capacity is 87MW.
